

**PROPOSED ON-BILL NOTICE LANGUAGE:**

GMP recently filed a request with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) for approval of a multi-year regulation plan, which establishes the process by which the PUC will regulate utility rates for three years, through September 30, 2022.
