

**GREEN MOUNTAIN POWER CORPORATION
RESIDENTIAL SEASONAL TIME-OF-USE SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE**

COMPANY DESIGNATION: 22

AVAILABLE:

Throughout the Company's service territory.

APPLICABLE:

Service under this rate is available as an alternative to Rate 1 for single-phase electric service at secondary voltage in residences, individual apartments and farms. Incidental use for other purposes will be allowed provided that the Customer's load and/or use is predominantly as specified above; otherwise, the appropriate rate in the schedule of rates shall apply for all uses unless residential use is separately measured. Customers are required to have an advanced meter installed to measure seasonal peak use.

DURATION OF CONTRACT:

One year and thereafter until cancelled by the Customer.

RATE:

Customer Charge of \$0.651 per day plus
During Peak Hours: All energy at \$0.26771 per kWh.
During Off-Peak Hours: All energy at \$0.11411 per kWh.

ADJUSTMENT:

This rate schedule is subject to adjustment.

PEAK AND OFF-PEAK HOURS:

Peak Hours from May 1 through October 31 shall be a period of eight consecutive hours between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All other hours shall be considered Off-Peak Hours.

Peak Hours from November 1 through April 30 shall be a period of four consecutive hours between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. and four consecutive hours between the hours of 4:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. All other hours shall be considered Off-Peak Hours.

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CONDITIONS:

- 1) Bed and Breakfast establishments with a total of five bedrooms or less at the premises shall be considered predominantly residential use and shall therefore be eligible for service under this rate schedule. Bed and Breakfast establishments with a total of six bedrooms or more that also demonstrate that they pay annual Vermont Rooms and Meals Tax of less than \$3,000 shall be considered predominantly residential use and shall therefore be eligible for service under this rate schedule.
- 2) Specific Peak Hour periods may be obtained by contacting the Company. These Peak Hours will not be adjusted without prior notification to customers taking service on this rate schedule.
