## **Notice for Net Metered Customers:**

Beginning July 1, 2021, customers with net metered generation will be assessed the Energy Efficiency Charge (EEC) based on their gross electricity consumption. The Public Utility Commission approved, and Efficiency Vermont supports, this change to Rule 5.300 which funds the statewide energy efficiency services provided by Efficiency Vermont. These services help to accelerate Vermont's adoption of clean electric technologies, which reduce statewide greenhouse gas emissions.

For electric service rendered after July 1, 2021, the EEC for net metered customers will be determined based on each customer's gross monthly usage, including usage served by the net metering system. Customers that do not have a production meter attached to their net metered generator will be charged a fixed monthly EEC as approved by the PUC as follows:

•	Residential	\$6.80/month
•	Commercial without Demand	\$6.33/month
•	Commercial with Demand*	\$85.53/month
•	Industrial without Demand	\$586.49/month
•	Industrial with Demand*	\$1915.71/month

<sup>\*</sup>The listed Fixed Monthly EEC applies to the energy-related portion of Energy Efficiency Charges. For customers also billed based on demand, the EEC kW charges also apply to customer's peak demand for each statement period and this amount will be calculated and charged by the distribution utility and added to the listed Fixed Monthly EEC paid to EVT.
