## PROPOSED ON-BILL NOTICE LANGUAGE:

Green Mountain Power recently filed a request with the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for approval of a new multi-year regulation plan ("Plan"). The Plan sets the process for PUC regulation of GMP's rates over four years, from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2026. The Plan continues much of the framework of GMP's current regulation plan, and is designed to provide stable rates for customers and reliable, safe, low-cost and low-carbon power through a more resilient grid.
